















#### Preliminary Results - Overarching Themes




#### **Service Impacts**

"If that [data linkage] happens, why did my services get passed over?" – Group 2

"If it helps me get services faster or better then I want to know that it happens" – Group 2






#### Service Impacts

"The more information you give, the more help you get" – Group 2

"There'd be less double dipping" - Group 2





#### Service Impacts

"Not if it's going to be used against them" - Group 3

"Some information should be shared, but for instance, the food bank, they won't be able to last the whole month if only accessing one food bank but have a large family" – Group 3




#### **Control and Trust**




#### When should John be asked permission to **SHARE** his **PERSONAL** information

#### **Control and Trust**

• Access procedures:

"No volunteers, they don't care as much, they're only temporary... and not as experienced" - Group 2

"There should be a screening process so we know why they are requesting it and what their platform is. That would be very important" – Group 3

"Needs to minimize the harm to the individual" - Group 3



#### Accountability

If...then...

"If it helps someone else, take my info, as long as you don't slander me, don't call me a crackhead" - Group 2

"I think it's okay because everyone deserves help if they want it" – Group 1



#### Accountability

"I knew they had a physical folder, not an electronic one" - Group 3

"Transparency is important" - Group 3



#### Accountability

"It would be good for participants to find out if their anonymous information was used" - Group 1

"The information could help <u>us</u> figure out if housing in Edmonton even works!" – Group 2



#### Personhood

"I was one of the 769 families helped by family support. I ate some of those meals" - Group 1

"A lot of places I go to, I am a number. I don't like it, it's not personal." – Group 1





#### Surprises and Observations

- High level of engagement
  - (surveys are typically not well responded to)
  - 9/22 elected to be kept in the loop
- More interested in data sharing (with control) than anticipated
- Difficult to keep on topic salience of service access and quality often took precedence despite keen interest



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#### **Next Steps**

- Two more workshops planned
- More comprehensive analysis of all data
- Work to integrate findings into consent processes and organisational policies
