Acknowledging First Nations

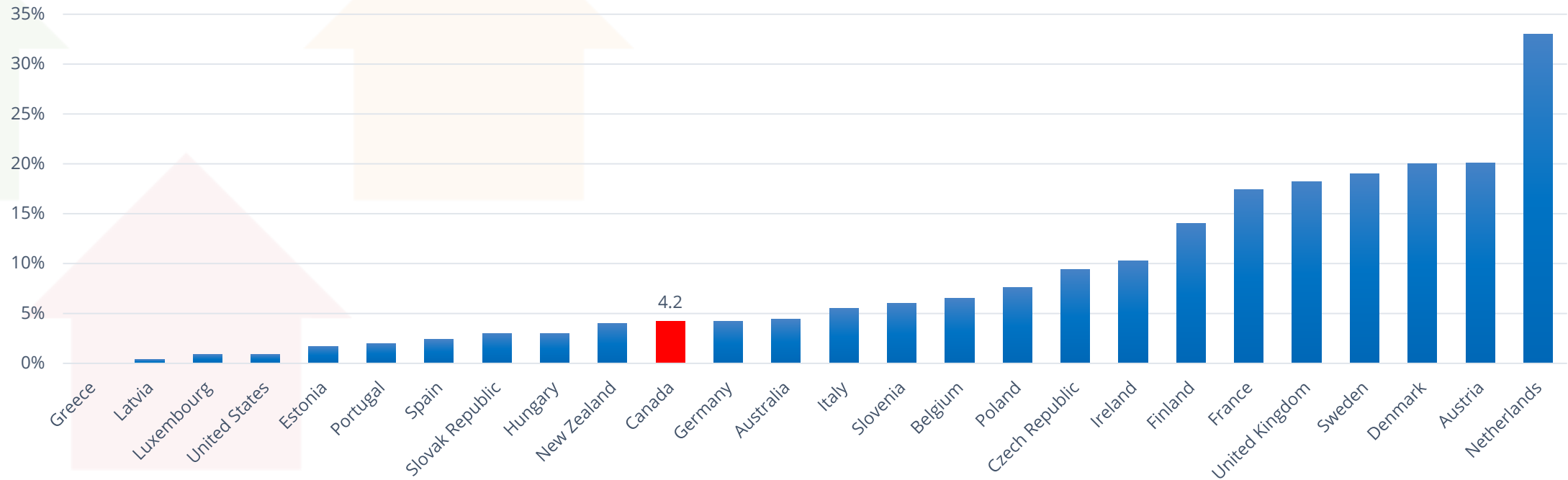
Acknowledging First Nations

We would like to begin by acknowledging that the land upon which we gather today is Indigenous land. We also recognize that the traditional Blackfoot name of this place, where the Bow River meets the Elbow River, is **Mohkinstsis** - which we now call the City of Calgary.

We would like to acknowledge that we are on the traditional land of the Blackfoot Confederacy - Siksika, Kainai, Piikuni, as well as the Treaty 7 territory, which includes T'suu T'ina and Stoney Nakoda, which is comprised of the three bands of Chiniki, Bearspaw and Wesley. Calgary is also home to the Metis people of Region 3.

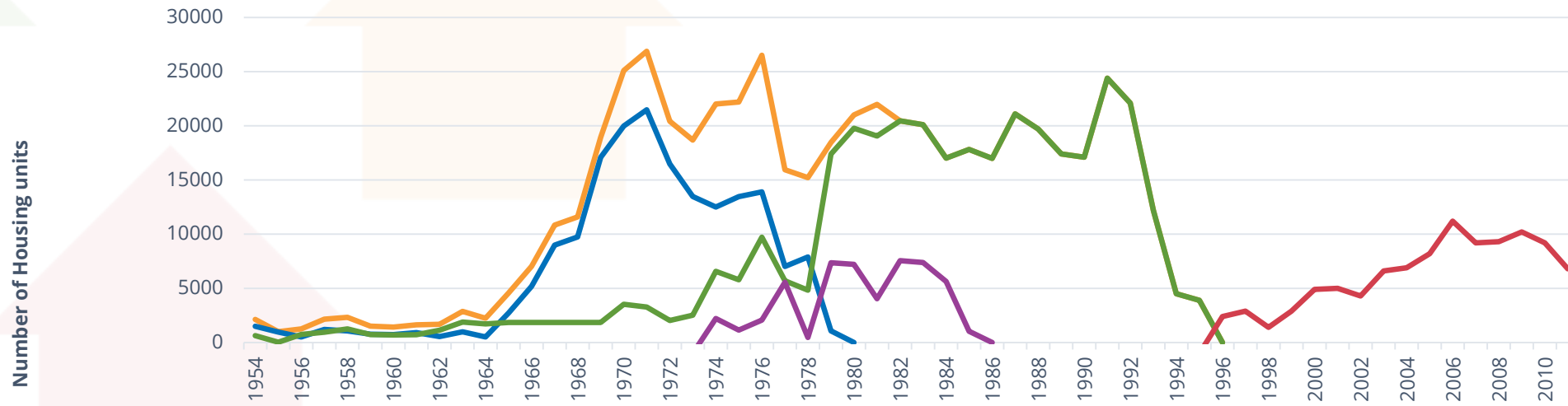
Social housing as a percentage of total housing stock for OECD countries in 2015

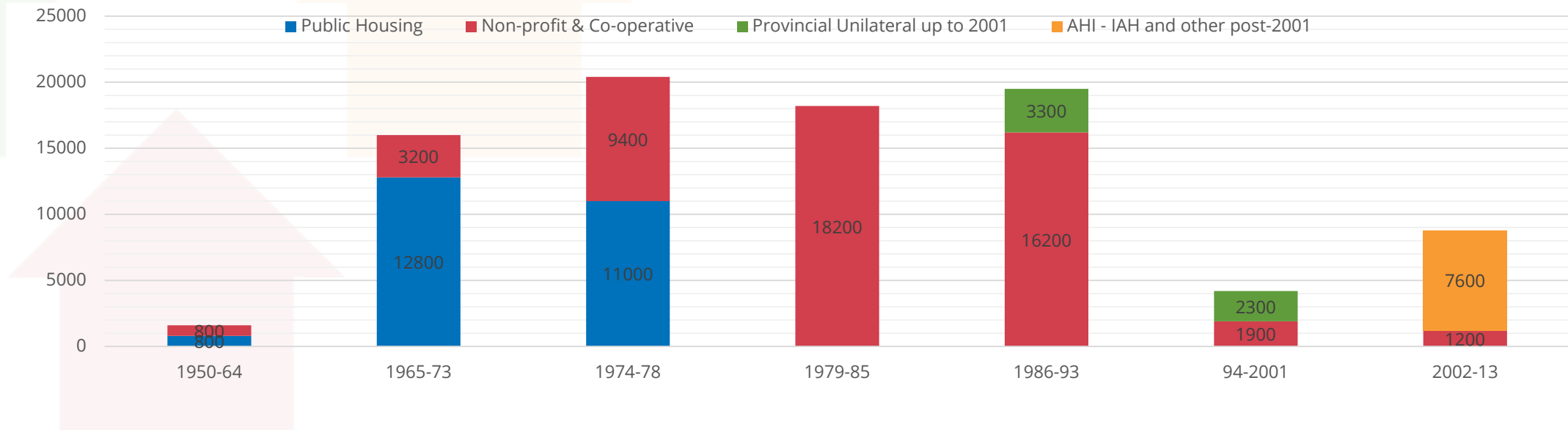
Annual Social Housing Commitments, Canada 1954-2011

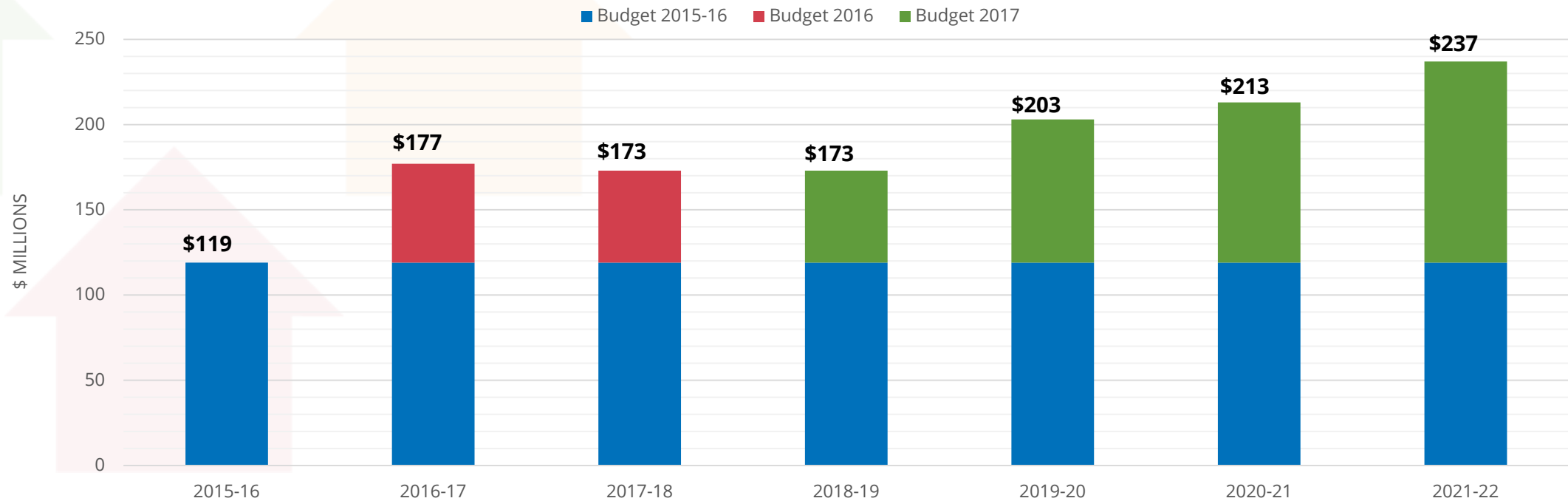

Average annual social housing commitments, Canada, by program period 1950-2013



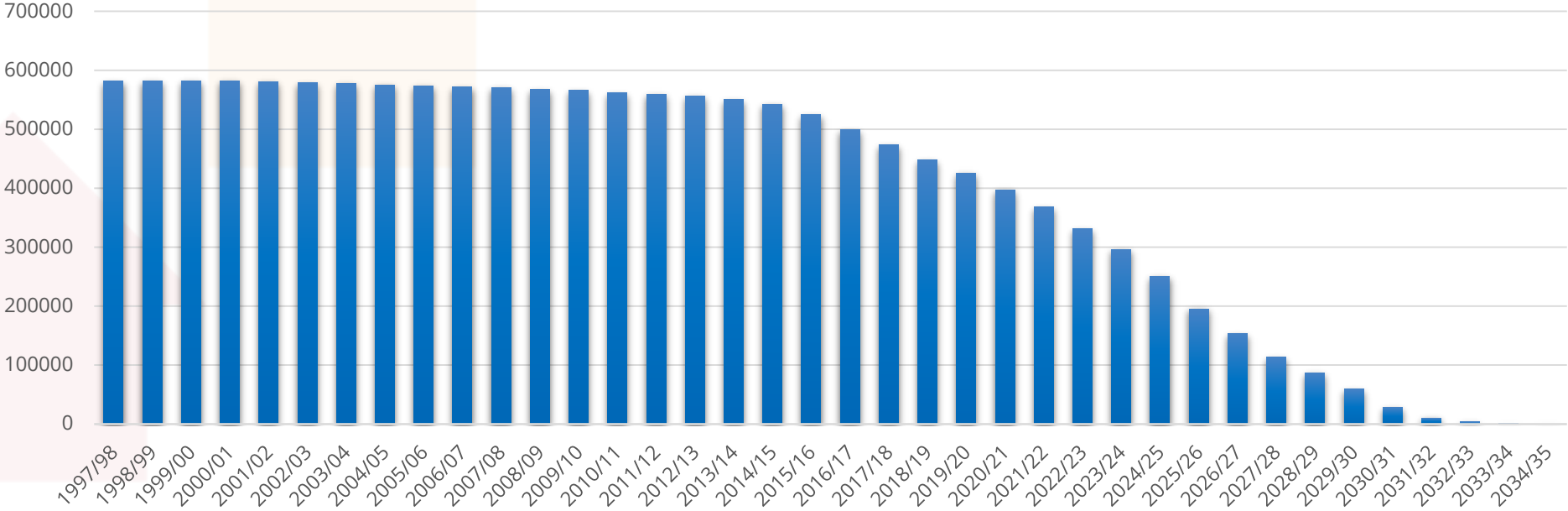

Annual Homelessness Partnering Strategy funding



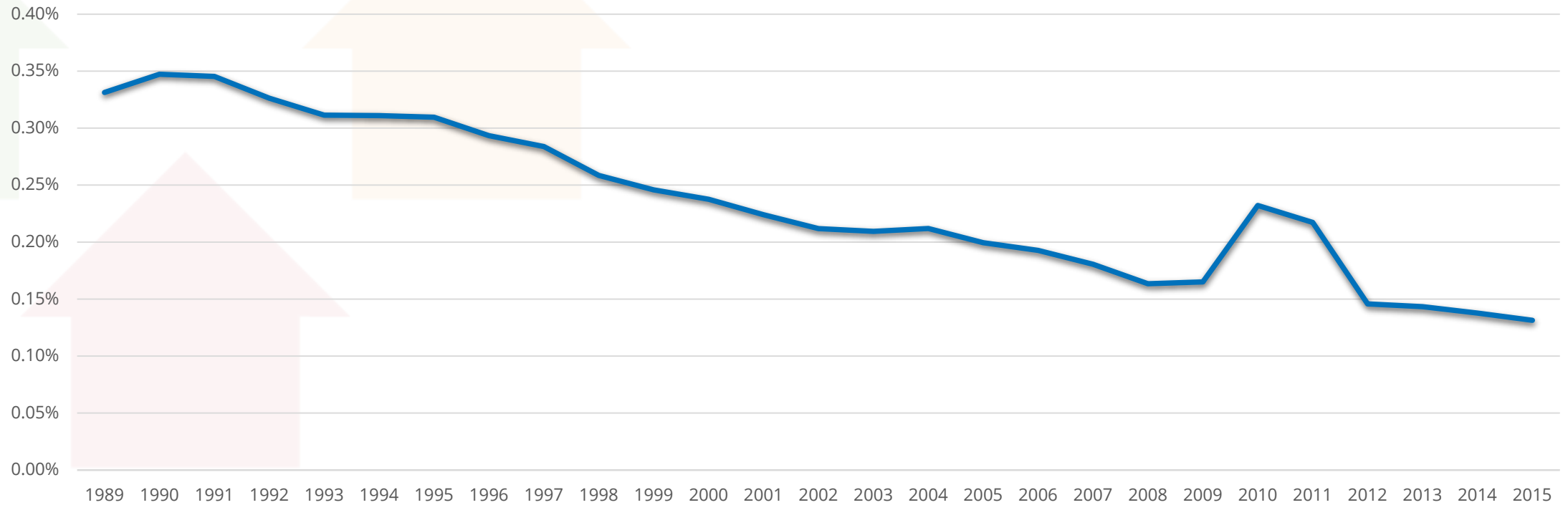

Expiry of federal subsidy, units by year under subsidy



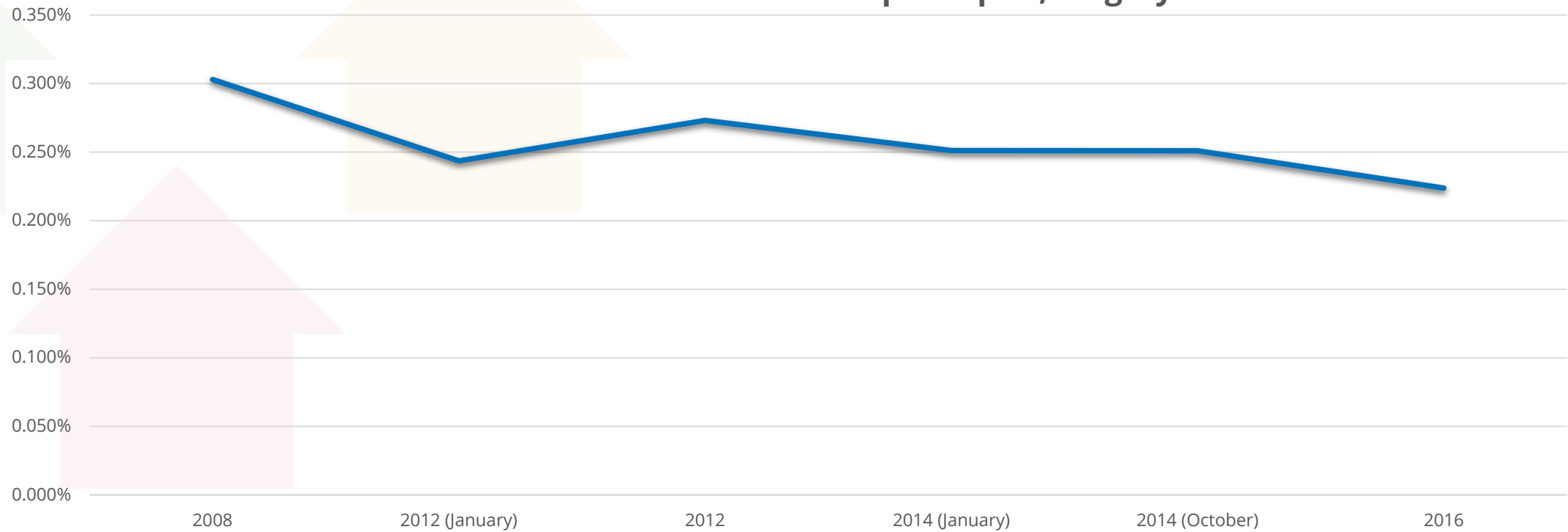

Federal Social Housing Investment as a per cent of GDP



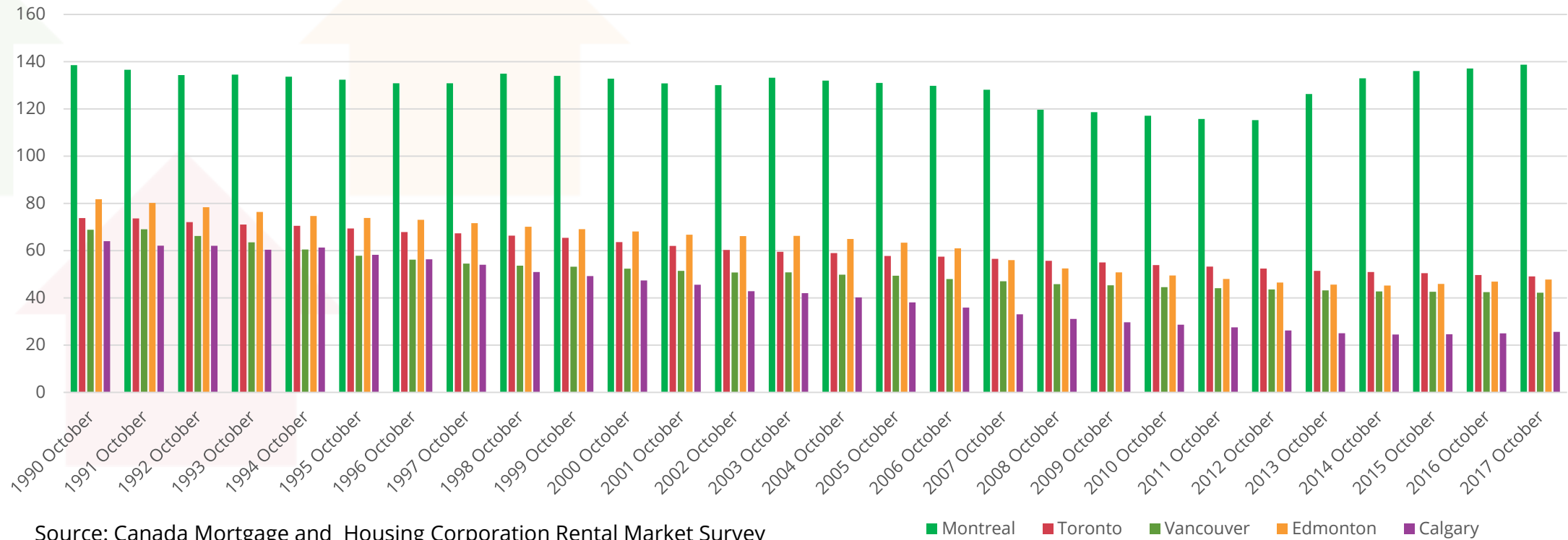

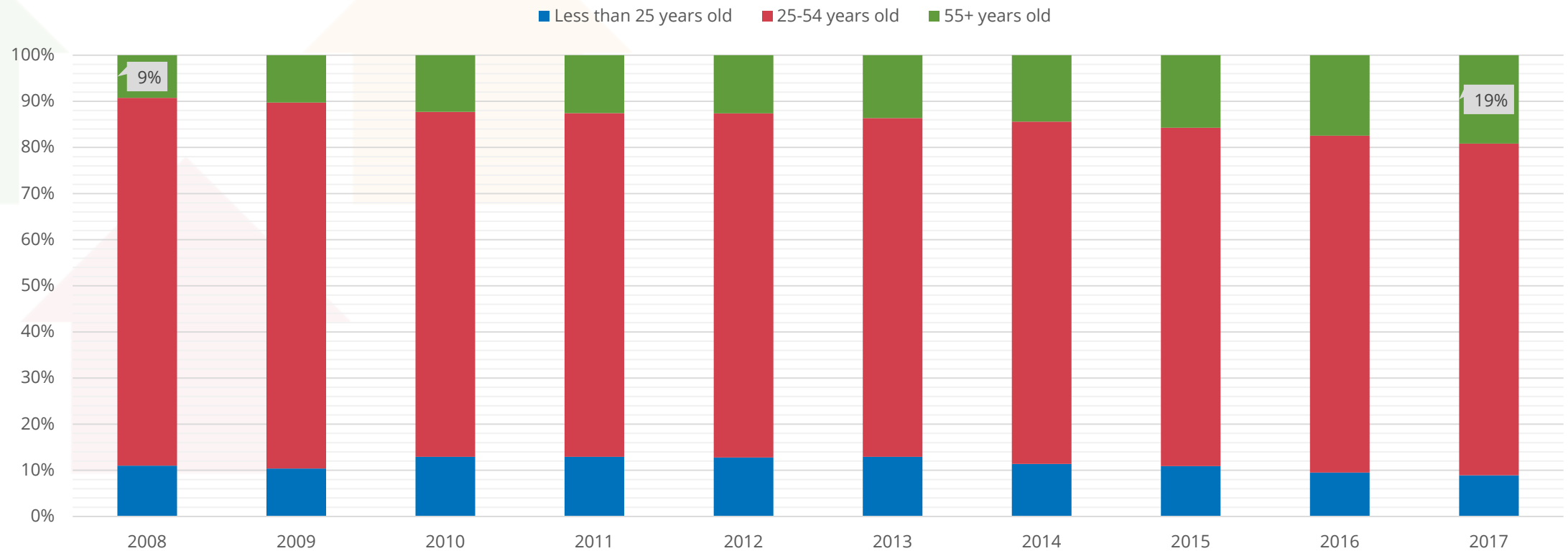
Stock of Apartment Rental Units per 1,000 People

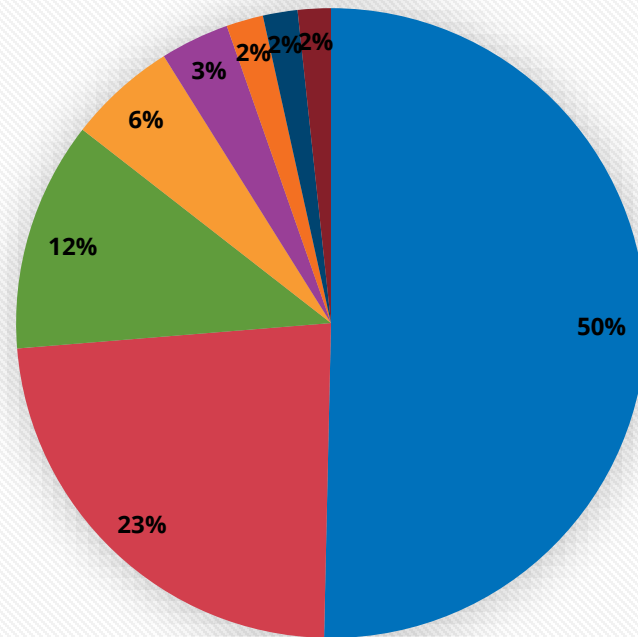
