



Number of homeless people sleeping outside per 10,000 population











Figure 3. Durées moyennes des épisodes d'itinérance et en logement stable chez les répondants en situation d'itinérance épisodique selon le nombre d'épisodes sur une durée de 3 ans¹⁴.
