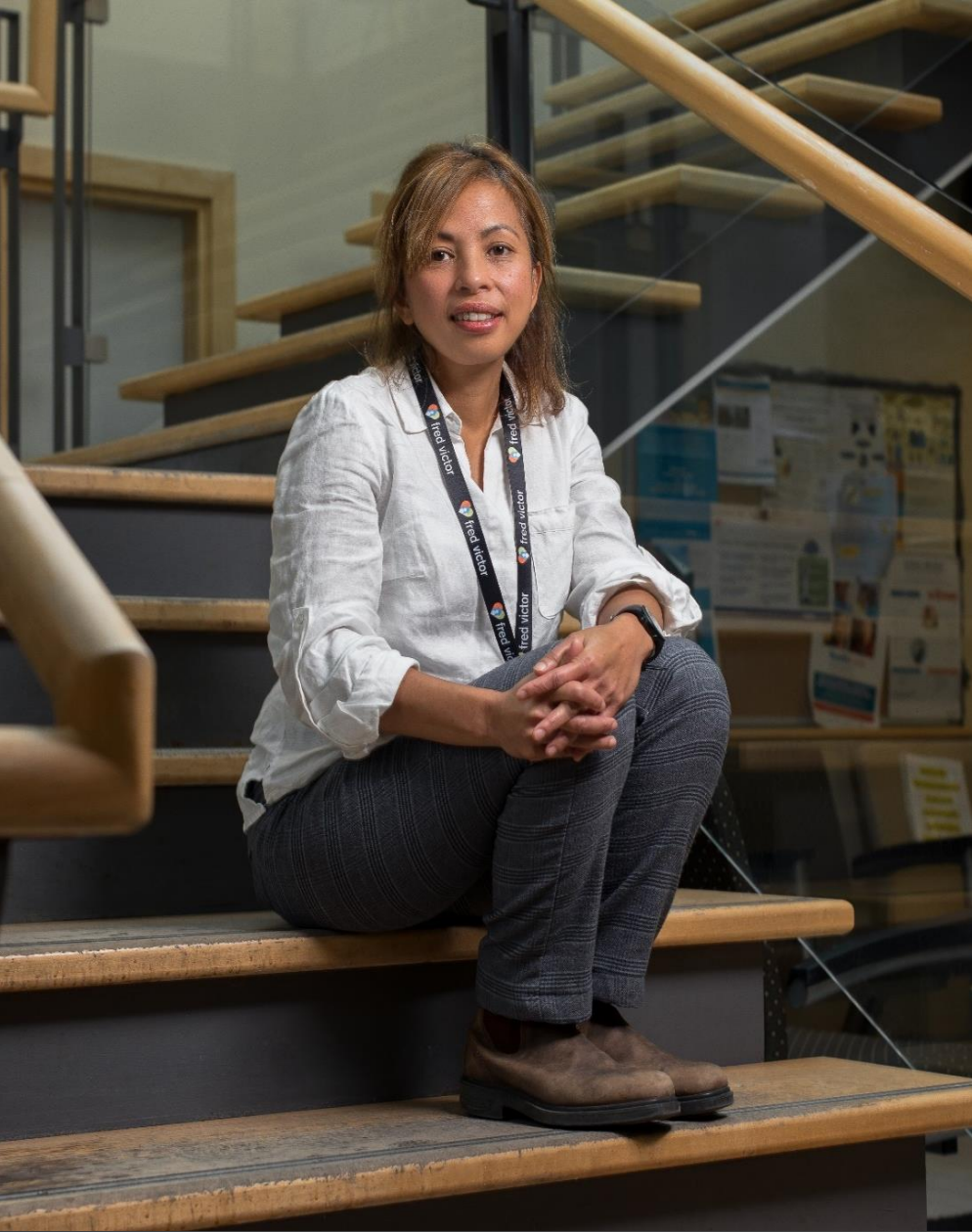

Prevention

- Eviction prevention
- Support families to end the cycle of poverty
- Improve financial security
- Support people to age in place
- Connect with people as they depart institutions (hospitals/corrections)



Rationale for Research

- Many funders and funder targets
- Multiple funder-mandated databases
- Most funders do not have targets around homelessness prevention
- Developing an easy-to-use tool to quantify homelessness prevention efforts

Origin of project

- Growing emphasis on prevention
- FV sought
 1. Working definition of prevention
 2. Categorization of its programs
 3. Some initial impact measurement

Challenges

- Approx. 60 programs at FV
- Very little measurement currently happening
- Current definitions vary across programs
- Multiple databases
- Clients currently accessing multiple FV programs

Method

- Lit review
- One-on-one interviews
- Online surveys
- Focus groups
- Guidance from advisory committee

Mapping of FV programs

- List created
- Three categories
- Five programs 'short listed' for piloting
- Two pilot programs identified (based largely on having good client-level data)

Piloting to begin

- We've identified each program's desired outcomes
- We're now putting draft output measures in front of each of the two programs.
- We'll make some calculations, which we'll put in front of each program.

Final report

- Going forward, what's needed to allow more (maybe all) FV programs to undertake impact measurement through a prevention lens?
- For example, what are the database requirements?
- How will the calculations get made, by whom and with what frequency?
